## ORDER (Date 13/10/2016)

- 1. This appeal under Sec. 10 of Madhya Pradesh Niji Vyavasayik Shikshan Sanstha, (Pravesh Ka Viniyaman Avam Shulk ka Nirdharan), Adhiniyam, 2007 (the Act, for short) and Sec. 10 (1) & (2) of Sansodhan Ahiniyam 2013 has been filed by Hakeem Abdul Hameed Unani Medical College & Hospital, Dewas against Admission & Fee Regulatory Committee's (AFRC for short) order No. AFRC/2016/3623 dated 06.08.2016 fixing fee of Rs. 66,000.00 per year for B.U.M.S. course for academic sessions 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19.
- 2. Appellant and Respondent were heard.
- Audited accounts for 2015-16 have been submitted alongwith appeal memo.
  Appellant submitted audited accounts for 2013-14 and 2014-15 which are taken on record.
- **4.** Appellant submitted that the institution had incurred a substantial deficit of Rs. 29 lacs in 2015-16 and further that there had been a significant increase in salary during the last 3 years which are verifiable from audited accounts.

- 5. Appellant submitted that the fee fixed by AFRC vide impugned order is not adequate to meet the requirement of the institution and hence a suitable increase in fee may be considered.
- 6. OSD AFRC mentioned that AFRC had considered audited accounts submitted by the appellant institute while fixing the fee vide impugned order and further that fee had been fixed from Rs. 55,000.00 per year fixed for previous three years block to Rs. 66,000.00 for the current three years block.
- 7. Audited accounts submitted by the appellant were perused. It is noted that the appellant institute had deficit of Rs. 29.00 lacs in 2015-16 and Rs. 3.52 lacs in 2013-14 whereas the institute had a surplus of Rs. 22.58 lacs in 2014-15. It is further noted that salary paid by the appellant institute had increased from Rs. 40.49 lacs in 2013-14 to Rs. 72.65 lacs in 2015-16.
- 8. Keeping in view the substantial deficit incurred by the appellant institute, particularly in 2015-16 and further keeping in view the substantial increase in salaries paid in 2015-16 over that paid in 2013-14; it is reasonable to increase fees to Rs. 71,000.00 per year for academic sessions 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19. Remaining terms and conditions of AFRC's impugned order would apply.
- 9. Para 11 of the impugned order is erroneous. Sec. 10 of the Principal Act has been substituted by Section 10(1) & (2) of the Amended Act, 2013. Hence, AFRC is directed to issue a revised order after necessary correction.
